Davenport.

Mr. Davenport is an Environmental and Occupational Health/Safety Expert. He retired at the rank of Captain after over 30 years of service in the US Coast Guard where his final assignment was Chief Professional Officer for a fleet of over 250 ships and 8,400 sea going personnel. During his distinguished career he accumulated 12 years at sea including command of two ships and one sail training vessel. Captain Davenport was detailed to the White House as a Special Advisor to two Vice Presidents. He also completed senior executive fellowships at the RAND Corporation and the Chief of Naval Operations Strategic Studies Group. He holds a BS in Marine Science from the Coast Guard Academy, and a MS in Environmental Science, with a concentration in Industrial Hygiene and a Minor in Hazardous Materials from UCLA School of Public Health. Captain Davenport served as the Operations Officer at Marine Safety Office Philadelphia serving NJ, PA, and DE communities along the Delaware River and Bay, directing response to both petroleum spills and hazardous chemical releases. Later he was assigned as Deputy Branch Chief for Safety and Health, the Senior Industrial Hygienist for the Atlantic Area to include 40 States, Europe and the Caribbean; and Safety Advisor to the National Strike Force. He maintains licenses and certifications as a World Safety Organization, Certified Safety Executive and Merchant Marine Master.
